NJ Issues New WWT Regulations

The new regulations for commercial systems with flows less than 2,000 gallons per day now require restaurants, cafeterias, institutional kitchens and "other facilities" discharging "large quantities" of grease to include a pre-treatment component in addition to a standard grease trap. While the local administrative authority can now approve these systems, the pre-treatment component must be designed to meet specific effluent criteria limits that previously did not exist within the code. Pre-treatment systems can vary considerably in cost, performance, and lifetime maintenance requirements. Whitestone is well versed in wastewater pre-treatment systems.
